Medical rehabilitation hospitals are the recommended post-acute venue for stroke survivors by the American Heart Association/American Stroke Association (AHA/ASA).

The AHA/ASA recommends that immediately following acute-care stays, stroke patients receive rehabilitation treatment at a medical rehabilitation hospital, rather than a skilled nursing facility. At a medical rehabilitation hospital, services are delivered by an interdisciplinary team of experienced healthcare providers.
