Aphasia is an acquired communication disorder that is caused by any disease or injury that causes damage to the part of the brain that controls speech and language, including:

- Strokes
- Traumatic brain injuries
- Tumors
- Neurological disorders

Aphasia can impair an individual's speech, comprehension, reading, and writing. While those with aphasia may have difficulty communicating, the diagnosis does not imply that a person's intelligence has been affected.
