

Rehabilitation AFTER AMPUTATION



At ClearSky Rehabilitation Hospital of Harker Heights, we provide specialized rehabilitation to patients who have had amputations to enhance recovery and minimize functional disability.

A national study shows that receiving inpatient rehabilitative care immediately after acute care is associated with reduced mortality, fewer subsequent amputations, greater acquisition of prosthetic devices, and greater medical stability than for patients who were sent home or to a skilled nursing facility.

Our physician-led, interdisciplinary healthcare team customizes treatment plans for patients following amputations and continues to monitor and provide skilled intervention as their healing and abilities progress. Our skilled clinicians prepare patients for prosthetic training through exercises, mobility training, and education on proper positioning.
