YOUR HOSPITAL TEAM

An interdisciplinary healthcare team works with you and your family members to customize a treatment plan that provides you the greatest chance of a successful recovery. We base your care plan upon your individual goals and capabilities.

Our services are led by physicians specializing in rehabilitation and include:

- Rehabilitation Nursing Services – for around-the-clock medical attention
- Physical Therapy* – for mobility and pain management
- Occupational Therapy* – for development and recovery of self-care skills and leisure participation
- Speech-Language Pathology* – for speech, cognition, and management of dysphagia or swallowing difficulties
- Dietary Services – for nutritional and special dietary needs
- Pharmacy Consults – for management of medications
- Respiratory Therapy – for improved breathing, energy, and stamina
- Case Management – for coordination of care during and after your hospital stay, including discharge preparations and arrangement of further resources and equipment, if needed
- Family Education & Caregiver Training – for information about stroke and the recovery process
- Home Evaluations – to prepare you for a safe return from the hospital

****During your hospital stay, you can expect to participate in at least 15 hours a week of physical, occupational, and/or speech therapy.***

OUR COMPREHENSIVE STROKE REHABILITATION PROGRAM

Our comprehensive stroke rehabilitation program is designed to maximize your recovery.

Our program includes review of 228 evidence-based recommendations from the American Stroke Association. Nursing and therapy personnel, who are **specifically educated in stroke rehabilitation techniques and modalities**, review every recommendation and apply the ones that fit your individual needs as a patient.

Our healthcare team works with you and your family members to ensure that you recover to **your fullest abilities**, helping to improve:

Thinking and reasoning abilities | Sensory issues | Bladder and bowel control | Safety awareness

The **depth and knowledge** of our stroke rehabilitation program allows us to provide you with the highest standards of care, while maintaining the ability to adapt and advance the program to new research and evidence as it occurs.



ADVANCED TREATMENTS

We offer advanced, evidence-based treatments to provide you with a successful recovery and quick return home, including:

- Yale Swallow Protocol for aspiration risks
- Brain Break Protocol for scheduled therapeutic rest periods
- PHQ9 to assess mental well-being and depression
- Ampcare's Effective Swallowing Protocol (ESP) to help with safe swallowing and eating

Our facility is designed to support you with your healing journey. The hospital features all private rooms, a rehabilitative gym with specialized equipment, a dining room with a dedicated chef and food service staff to meet specific nutritional requirements, and an activity of daily living space to allow you to receive therapy treatments in rooms that emulate home conditions.

RETURNING HOME

From the day you're admitted, a case manager will work collaboratively with you, family members, and the healthcare team to create a discharge plan that best meets your needs.

In preparation for discharge, you and your family members will be provided:

- Education regarding ongoing care, such as continued exercises, behavior modifications, home modifications, and assistive devices, if necessary
- Written instructions and prescriptions
- A medical report, which will be sent to your physician and other healthcare professionals

We plan to remain a partner in your healthcare after you leave the hospital, arranging further resources as needed, such as:

- Follow-up Physician Appointments
- Outpatient Therapy
- Home Health
- Durable Medical Equipment

OUR REHABILITATION DIFFERS

Medical rehabilitation hospitals like ClearSky Rosepine are required to:

- Be licensed and accredited
- Use an interdisciplinary team approach to care
- Have a physician with specialized rehabilitation training supervise medical services
- Provide rehabilitative nursing 24/7
- Offer patient therapy (physical, occupational, and/or speech) for a minimum of 15 hours a week
