COPD - CHRONIC OBSTRUCTIVE PULMONARY DISEASE

COPD is a chronic, inflammatory lung disease that obstructs air flow from the lungs. COPD includes emphysema, chronic bronchitis, refractory (non-reversible) asthma, and some forms of bronchiectasis.

SYMPTOMS

COPD symptoms usually don't present until advanced stages of the disease, and include:

- Shortness of breath, especially during exercise
- Consistent cough that produces mucus
- Wheezing
- Tightness in chest
- Frequent respiratory infections
- Swelling in legs, ankles, or feet
- Low energy

COMPLICATIONS

COPD can cause complications that may require an ER visit or hospitalization, including:

- Difficulty with mobility
- Increased confusion or memory loss
- Depression or other mental issues
- Other chronic diseases such as arthritis, congestive heart failure, diabetes, coronary heart disease, stroke or asthma

REHABILITATION TREATMENT
